Mr. Andrew Flagg presented the issues in *LaWall v. R.R. Robertson, LLC, et al.*, and Pima County Attorney Barbara LaWall's request that APAAC file an *amicus* brief to support his office's position on appeal. Mr. Flagg anticipates that the briefing will be complete by mid-September 2014, and recommends that any *amicus* be filed by the end of October 2014. Discussion was held. Mr. Tobin Sidles made a motion, seconded by Mr. Derek Rapier, that APAAC file an *amicus* in the case. Motion carried. Ms. Elizabeth Ortiz will have the responsibility of drafting the APAAC *amicus* brief.

Mr. Lando Voyles presented the issues in the *State v. Cahill [RPI Wilson]* special action and his request that APAAC file an *amicus* brief to support the Pinal County Attorney Office's position. Mr. Voyles indicated that the reply brief is due August 27, 2014. Discussion was held. Mr. Derek Rapier made a motion, seconded by Mr. Tobin Sidles, that APAAC file an *amicus* in the case to be drafted, upon confirmation by Ms. Polk of resource availability, by the Yavapai County Attorney's Office. Motion carried. The APAAC *amicus* brief will be filed by August 29, 2014.
