

- **National recognition – few states have a single approach**
- **Part of Arizona Department of Homeland Security’s Strategic Plan**
- **Requests outstanding for other states to connect**

Governance Model – Next Steps

- **Program has been a grass roots effort**

- **Current governance is technology driven with support from the LE community**
- **Formalize the program within the State**

 - ✓ **Includes expanding & leveraging technology**
 - ✓ **Arizona State Legislature has recognized the need**
 - ✓ **Identify an on-going funding source**
 - ✓ **Expand membership to other criminal justice agencies**
