### **PROPOSED APAAC DIRECT**

APAAC staff proposes to formalize and expand the in-office training program by rebranding it under the name "APAAC Direct", allowing offices to request APAAC Direct training via the APAAC website, and providing offices with electronic advertisements announcing scheduled APAAC Direct trainings.

The primary cost to APAAC of providing APAAC Direct training is that of staff time. If travel outside of Maricopa County is required for the training, then the trip will be combined with an office visit, and the travel expenses will be charged to staff travel budget, as opposed to the training budget.

APAAC staff propose a three-prong approach to meet the training needs of our leadership, prosecutors, legal assistants, support staff, and victim advocates:


