PINAL COUNTY ATTORNEY'S OFFICE COLLABORATES WITH CORRECTIVE SOLUTIONS ON DIVERSION PROGRAMS

COOLIDGE, AZ (2/13/15)- The Pinal County Attorney's Office sets the bar for diversion programs by joining forces with Corrective Solutions, a diversion program administrator for prosecutorial municipalities across the country.

At a soft opening today, PCAO and Corrective Solutions opened the doors to the new facility located in Coolidge. The building houses Corrective Solutions employees who work with PCAO to establish the most effective diversion curriculums for both adult and juvenile offenders based on their needs.

PCAO partnered with the organization to provide pre and post-filing plea diversion services in cases PCAO deems appropriate, including first time drug offenders, petty offenses and first time misdemeanor offenders. Some of the programs offered include, drug and alcohol treatment programs, community service programs, and programs which require drug testing and outside education. Also, Corrective Solutions now handles PCAO's "Bad Check" program. Offenders referred by PCAO are able to attend the mandated courses online or in person. The goal of these programs provides the necessary tools to these offenders to change future behaviors and ultimately establish low recidivism rates.

"Corrective Solutions tremendously helps the Pinal County Attorney's Office when it comes to providing diversion programs to those offenders we feel can benefit from education rather than punishment. This excludes violent and dangerous offenders. The offender pays 100% of the costs associated with the diversion programs, so again, this is another Pinal County Attorney's Office project that comes at no expense to Pinal families," said Pinal County Attorney Lando Voyles.

According to their website, Corrective Solutions serves more than 140 prosecutor offices across the country and uses the latest technology to ensure everyone, from the prosecutor's office to the victim get the highest quality service.
