PCAO AND MPD'S SHRED-A-THON SUCCESSFUL FOR ALL INVOLVED

FLORENCE, AZ (3/13/15) – The Pinal County Attorney's Office in conjunction with the Maricopa Police Department held the first Shred-A-Thon for Maricopa residents this past weekend with the goal of preventing identity theft and helping a local charity.

More than 8,000 pounds of papers got destroyed in the March 7th event and Maricopa's F.O.R. Food Bank collected nearly 500 pounds of non-perishable food, as well as, \$100 in donations. 100% of the proceeds were donated to F.O.R.

"The food bank serves 5-600 people every week so we need every bit possible. We thank everyone for donating and helping us in our mission to help families in our area," said F.O.R. Food Bank Director, Wendy Webb.

"We are glad to have been able to partner with the Pinal County Attorney's Office and we share in their commitment to keep residents of Maricopa safe from identity theft," said Maricopa Police Chief Steve Stahl.

"The Pinal County Attorney's Office and the Maricopa Police Department appreciate the support of the community for coming out and taking advantage of our event and contributing donations to the local food bank. This proactive approach helped feed Pinal families in need and helped us prevent identification theft," said Pinal County Attorney Lando Voyles.
