This two day training is for **CAC/MDT Forensic Interviewers and Prosecutors** from the same center to attend as **teams** to participate in the mock trial portion of the training. Additional forensic interviewers and/or prosecutors from a center may attend and participate in all activities, but only in the mock trial portion of the training on a space available basis. These do not have to be in teams, so multiple of one discipline can attend without a partner in the other discipline.

Participants will learn the latest research on forensic interviewing, along with strategies for defending an interview in the courtroom. Practical exercises will allow **Forensic Interviewers** to practice in the role of an expert witness. **Prosecutors** will learn strategies for using the expert witness, coping with cross examination of your expert witness and effectively crossing defense experts.

**Teams** are asked to submit a DVD and transcript of a forensic interview (adjudicated or resolved cases) to be used during mock courtroom exercises.

This training will be held at Glendale Regional Public Safety Training Center, about 3.2 miles from the hotel.

Facilitators for this training could include **Patti Toth, Rob Giles, Harry Elias, Amy Russell, Linda Cordisco-Steele, and/or Julie Kenniston.**

**The cost of this training is \$49 per participant.** Teams will be chosen first one team per CAC with secondary teams permitted if space is available. Participants are on their own for all meals except breakfast which is provided by the hotel. Scholarships are available from WRCAC to cover lodging and travel to training costs. You must complete a stipend application form to have your lodging and travel covered by WRCAC.
